



## Data Collection to support the World Bank's support the Zambia National HIV Program Efficiency Study

### Project Description:

The scope of IHM's assignment is focused on supporting the data collection component of the World Bank's support to the Government of Zambia and is focused around three tasks:

- (i) Coordinate the pilot test of the data collection instruments and assist in their final revision;
- (ii) Collect primary data related to service delivery at various selected sites in 6 provinces, 21 districts and up to 100 government health facilities as well as community based organizations (including NGOs) and providers in communities that form the catchment area of selected facilities will be sampled) ; and
- (iii) Conduct data entry, clean data and conduct any data "mop-up" as required by the level of completeness of collected data.
